What is Track?

TRACK NN is a social enterprise which supports autistic people to access employment. Since 2019 it has supported 25 people into paid employment and over 50 people into voluntary/work experience placements.

Currently just 16% of autistic adults are in full time employment, and with 1 in 69 people now having a diagnosis this means businesses are missing out on a wide range of talented individuals with often very unique skill sets.

What we offer?

We support autistic people on all aspects of their employment journey; from developing skills and experience in preparation for the workplace to training employers to ensure their workplace is aware and accepting of autism, so that they can benefit from a diverse workforce.



Our services

Preparation is key to successful employment ensuring employees feel safe in, and enjoy their work and employers get the best out of their team for a productive workplace. We offer the following:

Autism Awareness Training

Providing an understanding of Autism for all staff working within an organisation.

Environmental assessment and guide

We provide recommendations on making the workplace environment autism-friendly to support autistic employees achieve their full potential.

1-2-1 coaching and mentoring support for Managers or key representatives

A support programme for key staff and Managers to develop their knowledge and skills in supporting autistic employees.

Access to Work

Did you know that you can get government funding for a new autistic employee to support their induction, training and settling in process? The scheme is called Access to Work, which provides initial training and ongoing support for the autistic employees and their Manager.
