## **Schools**

#### 'Making Sense of Autism' 90 mins

Basic autism awareness training for teaching or non-teaching staff within any education setting who need an understanding of autism in their role (including teachers, TAs, office staff, governors, caretakers, drivers, and escorts).

#### 'Good Autism Practice' (GAP) 1 Full day

Practical knowledge, hands-on tools and techniques for all staff working directly with children on the autism spectrum (including teaching assistants, lunchtime staff, and teachers) - a host of resources & strategies discussed. (It is recommended that Tier 1 or other basic autism awareness training be undertaken prior to Tier 2).

The following courses extend knowledge and understanding and are designed to follow on from the Good Autism Practice module:

#### 'Extending and Enhancing Good Autism Practice' (GAP EE) 1/2 Day

Training deepens delegates' understanding, including theories of autism. Advancing skills in developing and applying strategies to facilitate progress and achievement, for teachers, teaching assistants and SENCOs.

### 'Good Autism Practice: Complex Needs & Participation' (GAP CNP) 1 Full Day

Focused training for staff in specialist settings who support pupils on the autism spectrum who have complex needs. The training aims to deepen participants' understanding of autism and ways in which they can support pupil participation, including development of their personal and EHC Plans.

## 'Good Autism Practice: Progression Framework 1/2 day

Introduction to the AET's **Schools Autism Progression Framework** outlining key features and guidance on how to use it. Hands on training for all staff involved in setting learning goals and recording progress for pupils. Show clear progression for your students in areas related to autism differences.

### 'Leading Good Autism Practice' (Tier 3) 1 day

### Requires some previous autism training; ideal for SENCO's / HLTA's/ Lead Practitioners

For staff who may train or lead other staff in their setting, focusing on developing good autism provision and strategy.

#### Prices, timings and number of participants

Courses can be provided 'in-house' to individual or families/groups of schools.
